Tourbillon sport

Today's watch is capricious, it aims to be complicated, unique and fashionable. Pierre Kunz takes it one step further in this sporty adaptation of his classic Triretro tourbillon.

The same complications, tourbillon and instantaneous retrograde triple seconds are found in a completely restyled model.

The 44 diameter case with crown protector is in brushed steel or BlackTop steel and comes with a textured rubber strap.

The dial is black or silver with ergonomic applied hours and minutes. The retrograde zone has a subtle transparency through which several brilliant set of wheels, so typical of Pierre Kunz, can be admired.

The final touch is the tourbillon decoration: black galvanic bridges and balance, while the top frame bridge gives way to a red racing car steering wheel in anodized aluminium for optimum precision.

Tourbillon Sport

Reference: G703 Sport

Movement: Mechanical with open case back, calibre PK 2103-2393, ø34.4mm, high 7.7mm, 36 rubies, 18000 A/h.

Functions: Tourbillon, Triple retrograde second.

Dial: sun-brushed by a galvanic treatment in black and white. With sport appliques numerals. Sectors covered with black Plexiglas.

Case: sport fluted Empire-style case in treated steel Blacktop, 44 mm diameter, high 15.05mm, sapphire glass and crown protection.

Strap: rubber with texalium texture.

Power reserve 70 hours.

Water resistant to 100 meters.
